



ACCREDITATIONS RULES

EXTRACTS OF THE ACCREDITATIONS CHARTER

I. Non-Transferability

Accreditation is strictly personal and can, in no circumstances, be transferred, whether free of charge or against payment, and must be worn visibly and permanently by the accredited person when present in or around the site of the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters.

II. Photos-videos

It is strictly forbidden to film, distribute and/or place at the public's disposal, either live or on a deferred basis, all or part, whether free of charge or against payment, any sound and/or animated image captured by whatever means within the site of the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters (in particular on the competition and practice courts or inside the areas subject to limited access, notably the locker rooms and the areas reserved for players), for any form of public access, and this via whatever broadcasting means (internet, radio, television, mobile telephones, accessories of data storage or any other current and/or future media), without prior and express permission by the Tournament Management.

III. Betting

For sports ethical reasons related to preservation the integrity of tennis competitions, each accredited person is forbidden to wager bets, directly or through an intermediary person, through whatever company it may be (notably via the intermediary of an on-line public communication service), in whatever form (including private bets between individuals) in relation to the Tournament within the site of the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters. Accredited persons are also strictly forbidden to communicate to a third party, through whatever means, the information obtained within the context or by virtue of his functions and which are unknown to the general public, relative to the Tournament and/or the actors of the Tournament.

IV. Match data and information

It is strictly forbidden for any accredited person to gather, store, broadcast, communicate, publish, deliver and/or place at the disposal of any other person or organisation, by whatever procedure and from whatever place within the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters, any data, statistics, information or fact he/she may have in relation to the progress of the tournament matches being played. Continued use of laptops and electronic devices is strictly forbidden in the areas bordering the courts, reserved for spectators.

V. Restrictions

Accreditation does not give access to any seats inside the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters. No duplicates will be issued in the event of loss.

VI. Penalties for failure to comply

In the event of non-compliance by the accredited person of one of aforementioned provisions, the Tournament Management may take any appropriate actions and/or sanctions, including but not limited to expulsion from the site of the Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters, temporary or permanent withdrawal of accreditation as well as the suspension of all associated advantages.
