

THE ATP WORLD TOUR MASTERS 1000

The Rolex Monte-Carlo Masters is part of the ATP World Tour Masters 1000, an exclusive category consisting of the nine most important tournaments in the world after the four Grand Slams.

The draws in these tournaments are composed of 96 or 56 players for outdoor events and 48 players for indoor events.

At the end of the season, the eight highest ranked players in the world participate in the ATP World Tour Finals, taking place in Turin in November.


